# F. Director of Hockey Update

- New draft of RFP document circulated by Nadia
- Options are to post the position for individuals and/or solicit applications from established companies in the sector
- Members asked to provide comments on the draft RFP by August 18th

## G. Coach Update

• Veronique presented an updated summary of coaches that have confirmed they are returning for the coming season, as well as status of credentials such as training, CRC etc.

# H. Esso Fun Day

- Karen presented an opportunity to leverage Esso Fun Day to recruit new players to hockey especially younger ages
- Esso provides people to help run the sessions ... and jerseys ... but WMHA would be expected to provide everything else from registration to promotion to ice-time
- Alternatively, WMHA could also arrange something similar using internal resources

### I. Back to Hockey Camp

- Registration now open, ice is secured and coaches on standby
- Norma will get some social media promotion going
- Bears are welcome to join WMHA camps

## J. Team Formation

- Total registration at 162
- U18 currently at 18 and may be oversized once Bears settled tentative lock at 19+2
- U7 currently at 11 one shy per WMHA "technical" requirements although WMHA preference is for 14 skaters
- Leaning toward a U7 Minor development team

- U9 currently at 29 which supports two teams may still lean towards two Minor teams based on heavy weighting of U8
- Will also explore using overage exemptions to move some number of U8s down to U7 to fill out that roster
- U11 Rep team likely to be acclaimed based on 13 (12+1) registration ... which is just shy of the WMHA preference of 14 ... and can also affiliate C players to bolster the roster
- U11C currently at 16 so set for one team
- U11F currently at 11 ... so still 3 shy of preferred numbers but likely to declare a team
- U13 currently 32+3 with majority (26) registering for Rep but will end up with two teams
- U15F has 16 for Competitive and 4 for House
- Will form one U15F with preference to local Whistler registrations two Squamish females currently wait-listed
- We have approval for three overage U15F Whistler females
- U15 integrated currently at 5 skaters ... and assuming three cuts from Bears ... plus one U13 playing up ... so could get to 8+1
- One option is to over-age those 5 skaters to U13 ... but they would have to play House
- Another option may be to over-age some of the first year U18 down to U15 given we're already over-sized at U18

- Cory Koop suggested Whistler consider hosting a tournament
- Potentially a fundraising opportunity with registration fees and partnerships
- Discussion regarding applicants for paid coaching positions for coming season
