

TEAM UNIFORMS

Each player is issued a uniform at the beginning of the season. The uniform consists of a red home jersey and socks and a white away jersey and socks.

It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the jersey is well cared for during the season and returned at the end of the season. Please see the uniform care instructions to ensure you are taking the best care to look after your jersey.

If your jersey is damaged throughout the season, there is a fee associated with replacing it. Please inform your team manager if you experience this.

Uniform Care

In order to ensure that we maximize the life expectancy of our team uniforms, please review and respect the following policies:

- 1. Uniforms are to be worn for games only.
- 2. Iron on patches should not be added to jerseys, this includes A and C patches.
- 3. Uniforms are to be carried to games on a hanger, or on a hanger in a garment bag. Any garment bag will be fine. Please treat your uniforms with respect and do not leave them on the changing room floors.
- 4. Uniforms are **NOT** to be placed inside your hockey bag. This will prematurely wear them out due to the Velcro straps on your equipment and the sharp blades of your skates. It is suggested that you use a garment bag to store them.
- 5. Please wash your uniform regularly.
- 6. Hang dry your jerseys, do not put in the dryer.
- 7. Name bars or company logos are not permitted on any team jerseys, unless approved by the WMHA board of directors.

Uniform Cleaning

Please take the time to wash and return your game jerseys

1. Washing instructions: Wash inside-out in cold or warm water, and hang dry. Do not use any bleach or fabric softeners.

- 2. If the uniform has not been washed for a while, please soak it with OxiClean or with Baking Soda prior to washing to remove the strong odors.
- 3. Ensure your jersey is washed weekly.
- 4. Ideally, your jersey is stored on a hanger.

Uniform Return

Both the home and away jerseys need to be returned after the last game of the season. How and when, will be determined by the individual team manager. The final date of return for jerseys is March 31st as inventory will be taken after this and any missing jerseys will be charged to the player. Socks are to be kept.

Jerseys must be cleaned prior to returning to the lockers. They need to be returned on a hanger.

Once your jersey kit is returned, you will receive a confirmation email of the return. The team manager will collect the team jerseys as per the return request below.
